



NCAA DIVISION 1 EJECTION/INCIDENT REPORT

During the regular season, a report must be submitted to the offending team's Conference Coordinator of Umpires, and the National Coordinator of Umpires, following a game in which any participant has been ejected. **This report must be submitted to the Conference Coordinator of Umpires, within eight (8) hours of the completion of the contest.** During the post-season, a report must be submitted to the National Coordinator of Umpires following any Division I Regional, Super Regional or College World Series game in which any participant has been ejected. Also, a report should also be submitted, following any game, for any other instance for which an umpire believes the attention of the Conference Coordinator of Umpires and/or the National Coordinator of Umpires is required.
