This camp is held at Central Michigan University in conjunction with head coach **Ernie Zeigler's Central Michigan University Basketball Camps**. Central Michigan University has an outstanding facility for hosting a basketball camp. We utilize 6 air-conditioned full-size courts in the intramural facility, courts in the multi-purpose building and CMU's main court located in Rose Arena. There is also access to a championship size swimming pool and hot tub.

Our officiating camp is designed for both high school and college basketball officials looking for advancement to the next level. We focus on both high school and college rules, along with 3-person mechanics. For those of you who are serious about officiating and want to enhance your officiating careers, *this is the camp for you!* Each camp will start with registration at 8:30 AM on Day 1 and conclude on Day 2/3 at approximately 2:00 PM. *Please note that all college women's officials attending either session will be paired with similar partners for all games officiated. Women's college rules will be utilized in their games.*

The Camp Director is **John Kirk**. A veteran collegiate basketball official from Michigan; John retired from officiating after 34 years of wearing the striped shirt. For the past 14 years, he has served as the Supervisor of Officials (men's and women's) for the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. This NCAA Division II conference's geographic coverage includes the states of Michigan and Ohio. He has also served as the Supervisor of Officials of the Saginaw Valley Conference (high school) for the past 35 years.

Guest speakers and participants will be Marcy Weston (past NCAA National Coordinator of Women's Basketball Officiating), Ted Hillary and Jerry Sauder. Both Ted and Jerry are well known Division 1 Men's officials. Ted has officiated in the NCAA Division I post season tournament for the past 25 years and has officiated in two NCAA Final Fours. Jerry Sauder currently officiates in four Division 1 conferences and provides our camp with an outstanding background in the officiating field.

Each camper will be videotaped and critiqued on their mechanics and officiating technique. These tapes will be yours to take home for post camp review. ***Campers must supply their own blank videotape.***

The Staff at each camp will be comprised of accomplished active men's and women's officials. These individuals are selected for their ability to teach in the classroom and on the court. **Our goal is to deliver to each of you the best camp experience possible.** We guarantee that you will leave these camps with a thorough understanding of mechanics and the philosophies necessary to be a quality official. In addition, this camp will offer you an opportunity to be evaluated by assignors that provide officials to approximately 100 schools. These assignors are looking to promote you to the next level of officiating. Take advantage of this opportunity.

You will be officiating in front of both college and high school conference assignors that are looking to add officials to their staffs. This is your opportunity to show them you can be a valuable member of their staffs. Each year many officials have been added to various staffs as a direct result of attending this camp.
